

Zygomatic Implants

Some patients present with very little bone quantity and poor bone quality after years of wearing dentures. These patients now have an option of fixed teeth with the Zygomatic Implant option.

Surgery usually involves General Anaesthesia for a quad zygoma case at Blackrock Clinic. Local Anaesthesia with IV sedation is an option when placing two single zygomatic implants. Temporary teeth can be fitted on the



day or several days later. The time to final teeth is usually three months. The procedure involves placing the implants in the mouth along the upper shrunken jaw bone and then inserting into some solid cheek bone.

Advantages of Zygomatic Dental Implants

The most significant advantage is patients no longer need to wear a denture and experience the social embarrassment that has held them back for





Another advantage is the the new fixed permanent bridge does not cover the palate. Patients can now appreciate the taste of food better improving quality of life. The implant bridges are easy to maintain and instructions will be issued on home care with regular long term review appointments for cleaning sessions with Glycine. The bridge fits the same as a conventional "All-on-4" bridge as in the above illustration.
